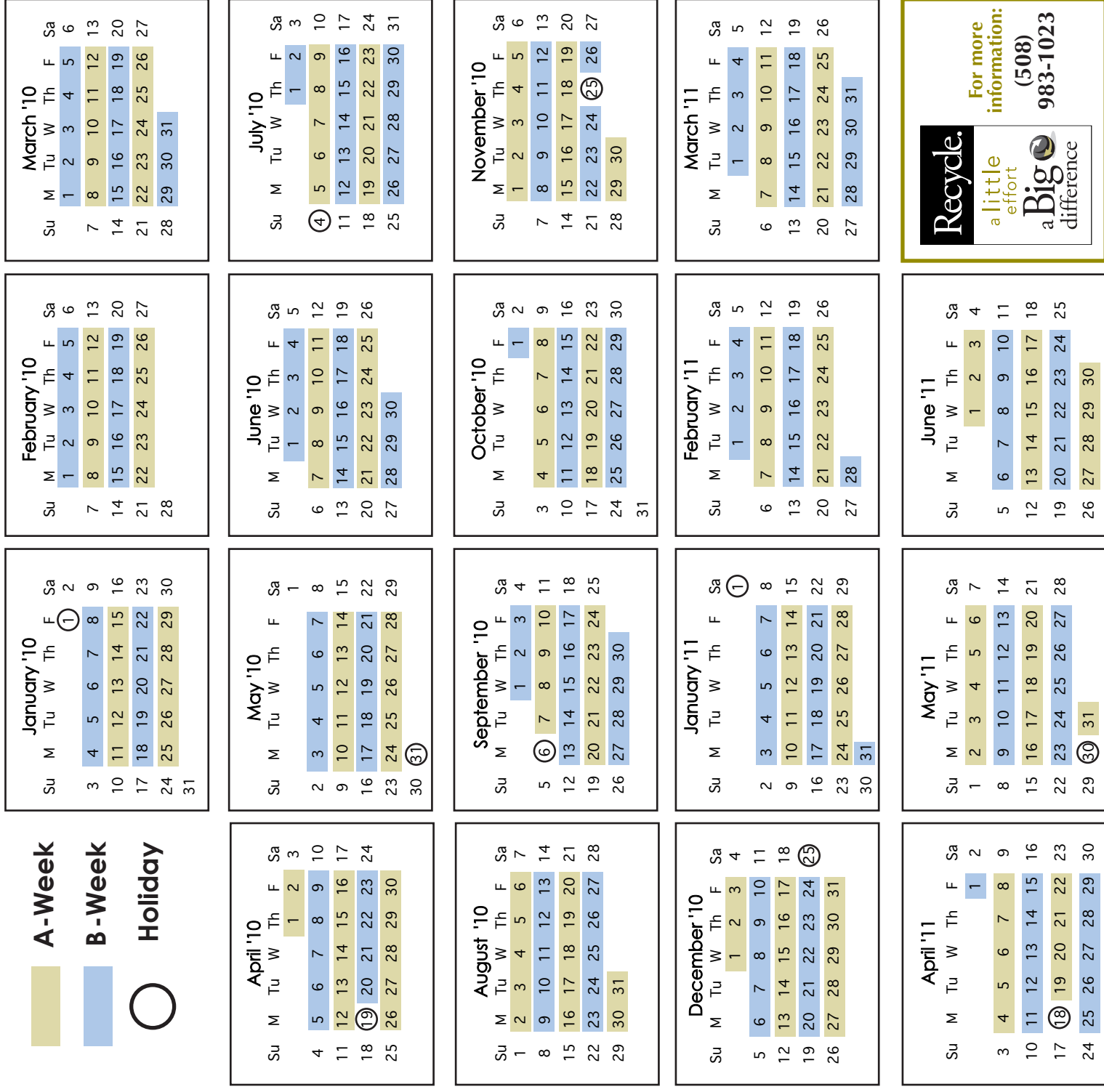
Recycling Collection Schedule

Recyclables are collected every other week on your regular trash collection day. Place at curb separate from trash by 7 AM. All A WEEKS (see list on left) are collected during weeks highlighted in GREEN on the calendar below and all B WEEKS (see list on right) are collected during weeks highlighted in BLUE.

Holiday Schedule

Whenever a scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day. Friday's collection will be on Saturday. Holidays are circled.

Note: Regular collections will be made on Martin Luther King Jr. Day (01/18/2010 and 01/17/2011), Presidents' Day (02/15/2010 and 02/21/2011), Columbus Day (10/11/2010 and 10/10/2011), and Veterans Day (11/11/2010 and 11/11/2011).

For all residents with municipal trash collection

- Newspaper, with inserts
- Magazines, catalogues, and phone books
- All mail and paperback books
- Office paper; shredded paper
- Paper bags
- Paperboard (e.g. cracker, cereal boxes)
- Cardboard boxes. Flatten/cut to 3' x 3' x 3' or smaller.

No soiled paper or pizza boxes • No plastic bags

- Clear, green and brown glass bottles/jars. Rinse, remove lids, corks. *No broken glass, window or auto glass, dishes, glasses, Pyrex.*
- Tin, steel and, aluminum cans. *No paint, aerosol cans, or aluminum foil.*
- Plastic bottles and jars marked  - . *No lids, motor oil, or chemical containers.*
- Milk and juice cartons

No plastic bags, toys, or foam packaging

Remember

- Please recycle everything possible!
- Flatten/cut cardboard boxes to 3' x 3' x 3' or smaller (to fit in truck) and mix with other paper products (e.g. newspapers, magazines).
- Keep paper items separate from commingled containers and place (6 ft. or more) away from trash at curb by 7AM.
- Flatten plastic bottles, metal cans and cartons for extra space.

RECYCLE EVERYTHING POSSIBLE

Please review the expansive list of recyclable materials (especially paper products) and recycle everything possible.

RECYCLING BINS & CONTAINERS

Recycling bins, or curbside recycling stickers, if you use your own container (e.g. small barrel, laundry basket), can be obtained from the Department of Public Works at (508) 497-9740.

CARDBOARD RECYCLING

Cardboard is banned by the Mass DEP from being thrown out as trash. Trash vendor will not collect boxes, but recycling vendor will collect *flattened* boxes. Cardboard boxes must be flattened and broken down/cut to a size of 3' x 3' x 3' or less in order to fit in the curbside recycling truck. Residents can also recycle cardboard and other mixed paper in drop-off collection containers at E.L. Harvey and Sons on Route 135.

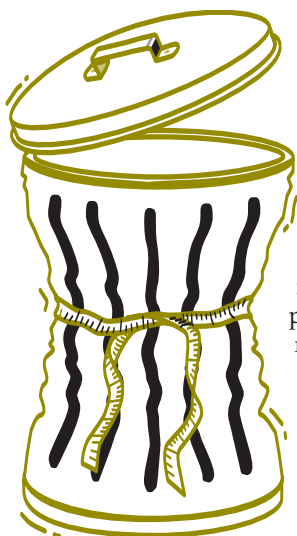

- Car batteries
- TVs and computers
- Large home appliances
- Construction and demolition debris
